Planning and coordination

- Analyze past logistics data to forecast volumes, critical areas, and bottlenecks.
- Share your forecasts with your carrier so that routes and capacity can be adjusted in advance.
- Coordinate your suppliers and internal teams to ensure the availability of inventory and resources.
- Update your operational procedures: extended hours, pickup protocols, contingency plan.



Preparation and operational effectiveness

- Standardize packaging and formats to speed up operations and optimize loading.
- Check the compliance of special packaging (fragile products, regulated products, etc.)
- Schedule pickups by time slot to avoid traffic jams.
- Perform a quick quality check before shipping: weight, labeling, packaging integrity



Real-time tracking and responsiveness

- Continuously monitor key indicators: volumes processed, on-time delivery rates, etc.
- Set up automatic alerts for delays, incorrect addresses, or absences.
- Ensure proactive communication in the event of unforeseen circumstances
- Work with your carrier to quickly reschedule blocked or delayed shipments.
